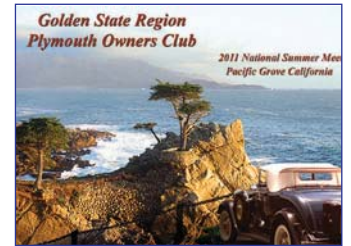




## 2011 Summer National Meet, hosted by the Golden State Region Pacific Grove, California - July 13 through July 16, 2011

All rooms should be reserved by cut-off date, afterwards standard hotel rates will apply. Additional days and upgraded accommodations are subject to hotel availability and standard hotel rates. ### Scheduled Activities

**Thursday, July 14th:** Tour Guide Tod Fitch. Driving tour to Big Sur. Depart the meet hotel at 10:30 AM for an hour long 36 mile drive along scenic California Highway 1 over to the Nepenthe restaurant in Big Sur. <http://www.nepenthebigsur.com/>. Along the way we will stop for photographs at the famous and photogenic Bixby Creek Bridge. The restaurant has fabulous views down the rugged coastline. After lunch we will return along the same route. This restaurant is usually crowded and we will need to know how many people the restaurant should expect. The group size limit is 40 guests so please make your decision as soon as possible. **Friday, July 15th:** Tour Guide Tod Fitch. Tour to historic Mission San Juan Bautista <http://www.oldmissionsjb.org/> Depart the meet hotel at 9:30 AM for approximately 2 hour drive over mostly back roads, through Elkhorn Slough National Estuarine Sanctuary and up San Juan Bautista. We will take a couple of hours in town, enough time to tour and wander the mission grounds and have lunch in a great restaurant. Then it will be off on the old highway that was the original route of US 101 before the current alignment was built in the 1930s about a 45 minute drive to Salinas and a tour of the National Steinbeck Center in Salinas <http://www.steinbeck.org/> Our return to Pacific Grove from Salinas will take about an hour and we should be back by about 5:00 PM. **Saturday, July 16th:** Tour Guides, Leslie Fitch and Kim Hunt Ladies/spouse bus tour for lunch and shopping in Carmel.

Our last stop is Mid Valley where we can visit Boete Winery and Chateau Julien. You will then be returned to Portola Plaza with all the wonderful memories, new friends and wines you have collected.
